

For what purpose will your personal data be processed and what is the legal basis for the processing?

Processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the controller (University of Jyväskylä), a customer relationship is established between you and the University of Jyväskylä when you enroll in a class of Academic Sports.

What personal data do we process?

Personal data is obtained from the data subject at the time of registration. Contact information will be stored in the service.

Photographs or video can be taken in sport classes if it is suitable for the students and they give oral or written permission to do so. Photos can be posted to the University of Jyväskylä and Academic Sports website, social media accounts and other university publications. Where images are used for commercial purposes, separate written consent for the use of the images is requested.

Who will have access to your data?

Your personal data is processed by Academic sports employees at the University of Jyväskylä.

The data processor is Enkora, which is the service provider. In connection with the maintenance and support service included in the contract, the data processor has access to the personal data of persons enrolled in sport courses at the University of Jyväskylä.

If necessary, the University of Jyväskylä may disclose the names and contact details of participants to the authority in order to trace the chains of infectious disease Covid-19. The processing of your contact information in this case is based on protecting your vital interests (your health) and protecting the public interest (others) from Covid-19 epidemic.

Will your personal data be transferred outside the EU/EEA area? How are the transfers protected?

The personal data will not be transferred outside the EU/EEA area.

For how long will your data be processed? Will the data be archived? (Retention periods)
Outdated data will be removed yearly (if there are no new registrations within a year).

You also have the right to erasure.

Your rights as a data subject

As a data subject, you have the following rights:

- Right to access
- Right to rectification (remember to keep your contact information up to date)
- Right to erasure ('right to be forgotten') in some cases
- Right to the restriction of processing in some cases
- The University has the obligation to notify any third-party recipient of the data about your requests for a rectification or erasure of your personal data or a restriction of processing.

- The right to object to the processing. For example, when your personal data are processed for the purposes of direct marketing, you have the right to object to the processing at any time.
- Right to data portability in some cases
- The right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling, which produces legal effects concerning you or would similarly affect you significantly.
- Right to be informed of any information security breaches causing a major risk
- Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority
